

PROJECTS IMPLEMENTED IN 2021

Since its inception, the Christ Fountain Solution Outreach Foundation (CFSOF) has been committed to implementing impactful community-based projects that address the most pressing needs of vulnerable groups across Nigeria. Guided by our mission to empower youths, support families, and uplift disadvantaged communities, we have consistently delivered programs that promote self-reliance, dignity, and long-term well-being. Some of the project includes:

1. WIDOWS SUPPORT PROJECT IN MAKOKO LGA

CFSOF launched the Widows Support Project, aimed at restoring hope and stability to widows facing economic hardship. The program provided financial support to start small businesses, and essential relief packages to meet immediate family needs. Beneficiaries also received mentorship and counseling, helping them regain confidence and resilience.









2. Abba Angel Academy Primary School Feeding & Support Program in Makoko LGA

Recognizing the role of nutrition in education, CFSOF implemented a program focused on primary school children. Through this initiative, we provided nutritious meals, school supplies, and other basic essentials to ensure that children remained in school, were attentive in class, and had the tools needed to learn effectively. This intervention directly improved both school attendance and classroom performance, while also relieving struggling families of the burden of daily school-related expenses.
