

PROJECTS IMPLEMENTED IN 2022

Since its inception, the Christ Fountain Solution Outreach Foundation (CFSOF) has been committed to implementing impactful community-based projects that address the most pressing needs of vulnerable groups across Nigeria. Guided by our mission to empower youths, support families, and uplift disadvantaged communities, we have consistently delivered programs that promote self-reliance, dignity, and long-term well-being. Some of the project includes:

1. PRENATAL CARE FOR PREGNANT WOMEN

CFSOF reached out to pregnant women within Ajourin Community health center, Itire/Ikate health center, providing them with vital prenatal care and support. Our interventions included regular health checkups, nutritional guidance, and counseling to ensure safe pregnancies and reduce maternal risks. We also distributed nutritional items to help improve their diet and overall wellbeing during pregnancy. Many of the women expressed relief and gratitude as they gained access to information and care that would have otherwise been out of reach. This initiative contributed to healthier pregnancies and better preparedness for childbirth.





2. POSTNATAL CARE FOR NURSING MOTHERS

Over the course of the year, we supported more than 100 nursing mothers with postnatal care services. These mothers received medical follow-up, breastfeeding support, nutritional advice, and emotional counseling to help them adjust to motherhood. In addition, we provided nutritional supplies and valuable items such as baby food, pampers, and other essential baby products to ease their recovery and improve the wellbeing of their infants. Our focus was to ensure that mothers not only recovered physically but also felt supported emotionally and socially. This effort strengthened maternal health and reduced the risk of postnatal complications.











3. SUPPORT FOR MOTHERLESS CHILDREN

Recognizing the vulnerability of motherless children, we dedicated time and resources to care for those admitted in hospitals. A notable case in 2022 was that of the Suliemon twins, who sadly lost their mother at birth. We stepped in to provide consistent care and essential supplies for the infants, ensuring they received the nourishment, comfort, and attention they desperately needed during their earliest days. This intervention not only sustained their health but also gave hope to their grieving family, showing that they were not alone in their time of loss.

Through such efforts, we bridged the gap of parental absence with love and support, improving the immediate wellbeing of these children and giving them a chance for a brighter future.









4. SUPPORT AT BARUWA COMMUNITY HEALTH CENTER

In addition to hospital interventions, we extended our outreach to the Baruwa Community Health Center, where we provided support to children in need of care. These children benefited from nutritional supplies, baby items, and basic health support, ensuring that families in the community had access to the essentials required

for healthy growth. Our involvement at Baruwa strengthened community trust and made quality maternal and child health care more accessible to vulnerable



families.





5 COMMUNITY OUTREACH IN IJESHA

Beyond health facilities, we also reached out to the people of Ijesha community, sharing foodstuff and other essential items to support households facing economic hardship. Families received staples such as rice, beans, and other basic necessities, alongside relief items to ease their daily struggles. This gesture not only helped to reduce hunger but also fostered a sense of solidarity and care within the community.

6. WIDOWS SUPPORT PROJECT IN IJESHA LGA

CFSOF implemented the Widows Support Project in Ijesha Local Government Area, reaching out to vulnerable widows with foodstuff, essential household items, and emotional support. This intervention helped reduce the economic burden on their families, improved their wellbeing, and gave them renewed hope and encouragement to face daily challenges.









7. HOSPITAL BILL SUPPORT FOR PATIENTS

CFSOF extended its outreach to hospitals by assisting patients who were unable to pay their outstanding medical bills. This included **mothers who had just given birth and sick children** in need of urgent care. By settling these bills, we not only relieved families of financial stress but also ensured that patients received timely medical attention and were discharged without delay. This act of compassion restored hope to many families and reinforced our commitment to improving access to healthcare for the most vulnerable.
