PROJECTS IMPLEMENTED IN 2023

Empowered Street Children in Ijesha

In 2023, CFSOF launched a transformative outreach project in the heart of the Ijesha community, aimed at restoring hope and dignity to street children who had been neglected and marginalized. Through this initiative, we empowered over 100 street children by providing them with essential food items to meet their immediate nutritional needs, while also investing in their future through educational scholarships. Many of these children had never stepped into a classroom before, and through our efforts, several were enrolled in schools for the very first time. The project did more than just offer relief—it reignited dreams, reconnected families, and inspired a renewed sense of purpose in the community. By addressing both short-term survival and long-term growth, we not only reduced hunger and illiteracy but also planted seeds of lasting transformation. This project stands as a testament to our belief that every child, no matter their background, deserves a chance to thrive



Impact Achieved

The results of this intervention have been nothing short of transformative. Dozens of children were successfully enrolled in schools ranging from primary to junior secondary levels, while others were placed in vocational training programs suited to their needs and interests. With regular follow-up and mentorship from our team, many have shown remarkable improvement in both academic performance and behavioral development. Beyond individual stories of change, the project has also had a ripple effect in the wider community. Local leaders and families began to engage more

actively with issues affecting vulnerable children, and community volunteers emerged to support the monitoring and reintegration process. Furthermore, partnerships were formed with local schools, healthcare providers, and religious institutions, strengthening the support network available to these children. This holistic approach helped us move beyond mere charity to true empowerment and reintegration.

LOOKING AHEAD

While the achievements of 2023 are significant, we recognize that this is just the beginning. There are still many more children on the streets of Ijesha and surrounding communities who remain at risk. In 2024, we aim to scale this project by increasing the number of beneficiaries, expanding to nearby communities, and deepening our intervention through after-school programs, family reunification efforts, and continued vocational training. We also plan to launch a community awareness campaign focused on child protection and education, and to work more closely with government agencies to push for systemic change. With continued support from our partners, donors, and volunteers, we are committed to building a future where no child is left behind—where every child, regardless of their background, has the opportunity to learn, grow, and live with dignity.
